Murdock Campus Center Public Membership and ABC Campus Usage Guidelines

Public Hours and Use

The Murdock Campus Center (MCC) Gym and Fitness Center will generally be open to the public on a user fee basis. The Campus Center is closed to the public when reserved for other activities or groups, or when maintenance or other needs arise. **Hours are subject to change without notice.**

Fees

Fees for use of the Murdock Campus Center (gym and fitness center) are due and payable at the time of application. Fees are subject to change without notice.

Release and Waiver of Liability forms must be completed and signed for each person listed on the Murdock Campus Center User Application. Parents or Legal Guardians must sign a release for their minor children.

Approved applicants will be issued a keyless entry code or an electronic/magnetic access card or device. **Sharing of access codes/cards, allowing unauthorized users into the MCC will result in revocation of access privileges.**

MCC and Campus Public Use Policy and Guidelines

- **Users may NOT invite guests into the MCC.**
- Persons driving on campus must observe posted speed limits and only park in designated parking areas.
- **Persons using the Campus Center facility are required to clean up after themselves and family members.**
- Individuals are to exercise care in the use of the facilities. Individuals and/or their parents are financially responsible for any damage they cause to the facility, equipment, or furnishings. Please report any problems with or damage to equipment to ABC personnel.
- Doors are to remain closed at all times – **Do not prop doors open or bypass locking mechanism.**
- No Smoking, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs are allowed on the ABC campus.
- No one deemed under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs will be permitted on the ABC campus.
- The MCC may not be open for use by individuals or groups that promote values inconsistent with those of the College. • No inappropriate language or attire is permitted on the ABC campus.
- No weapons are permitted on the ABC campus.
- Personal items are not to be left in the MCC. Items left in the MCC may be discarded.
- Children under 12 must be under the direct visual supervision of a parent, guardian or authorized responsible adult at all times (i.e. a parent or other responsible adult must be in the same room as the children).
- ABC will attempt to maintain facilities and equipment in proper working order but does not guarantee that these items will function properly at all times. No refunds or credits will be allowed for facility or equipment downtime.
- Parents are responsible for the actions of their children.

Failure to abide by these guidelines may result in revocation of Campus Center access privileges. Alaska Bible College reserves the right to terminate access to its facilities at any time and for any reason. When terminated for reasons other than violation of Guidelines, the College will refund the unused portion of access fees paid.
